## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON LIVING IN KIEL <u>ONLY</u> FOR SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS

The dormitories in Kiel do not belong to Kiel University but to other organisations. These organisations reserve a small number of rooms for international students which the International Center allocates.

The chances of obtaining a room in a dormitory can be improved by submitting an application to the International Center **before the deadlines listed below**.

The rent in the different dormitories currently amounts to approximately EUR 140,- to EUR 220,- per month.

The renting period in the dormitories is six months. Therefore the renting contracts always have to be signed for these six months:

- For the winter semester (application deadline June 15<sup>th</sup>) the renting period will be from September 1<sup>st</sup> of a given year until February 28<sup>th</sup> of the following year.
- For the summer semester (**application deadline January 15**<sup>th</sup>) the renting period will be from March 1<sup>st</sup> until August 31<sup>st</sup> of the same year.

In a few exceptional cases rental contracts can be signed for a different period of time. For this reason, you should take into account, that you may have to pay for one to two months although the room has not yet or is no longer occupied by you.

We generally recommend to decide in favour of a room in the dormitories (if available) and to accept the terms and conditions of the rental contract. It is rather difficult to find a living space on the private housing market at a reasonable price and often real estate agent fees and expensive deposits have to be paid.
